- This trip is open to current 9th-12th graders, with a maximum of 30 youth participants.

- A \$200 deposit is required. *Mail or drop it off within one week, payable to "PCCT" with "2025 YMT Deposit" in the memo line.*
- Early registration is encouraged and will be limited to PCCT member families and past participants for the first two weeks. Spots will be filled on a first-come, first served basis.
- Community members and additional friends will be placed on a waitlist and notified as soon as space becomes available.

Additional Details

Cost: \$400.00 per person. Includes participation fee and materials, vehicle rental and transportation, food, free day, lodging, work supplies, and a t-shirt. \$100 discount offered to families with a second participant.

Deposit: \$200.00 is due with registration. The balance (\$200) is due Sunday, April 13. Alternate arrangements can be made if needed and funds are available to subsidize costs. *See Pastor Tom for more information.*



Lodging: We will be staying at the New Hope Volunteer Village. There are bunk rooms and we will cook our own meals in their kitchen. There are showers and laundry on site as well as a meeting space for little churches.

Transportation: We will drive in rental vehicles from Chatham to New Bern, NC (approx 525 miles).

Free Day: We will take Wednesday off and enjoy the day outdoors and have dinner at a restaurant on the nearby coast.
